Participation Requirements

Do you want to be part of the German Design Awards? Then submit your project - provided it has been published or launched in the last five years. Exceptions apply to the categories "Design Classics and Re-editions" and "Startup". Concepts are also welcome.

The jury takes a close look - especially at innovation and sustainability. Show what makes your project special when you submit it. After all, sustainable design has long been a key topic - and those who are transparent here score double points.

Are you certified? Do you have a sustainability report? Have you developed a product or building passport? What circular strategies have you implemented? The more clearly you present these aspects, the more informed the jury's assessment will be - and you will show that you take responsibility and stand out from the competition.



The German Design Awards are divided into three main disciplines – each strong on its own, together showing how diverse and impactful design is today. Whether architecture, communication design, or product design – in all areas, quality, innovation, and the concrete contribution to societal and economic progress matter.

What they all have in common: All disciplines show how design is changing our world. The German Design Awards make this diversity visible – as an international stage for excellence and impact.



Excellent Architecture

Circular Design

Resources are limited. Your responsibility is not.
Circular Design is no longer an option, it's an attitude
– and is now made visible with its own additional category in the German Design Award.

Here, we award projects that think material, function, and lifecycle in a circular way. If you design today the way production must happen tomorrow, you show innovation and foresight.

Does your project fit into this category?

Is it modular, repairable, recyclable, or designed for a second life in the circular economy? Does it show how design works as part of a system? Then this stage is made for you.

How the evaluation works:

After your registration, you'll receive an additional questionnaire. Here you can provide proof, such as labels, certifications, or product passports – giving the jury the opportunity to assess your project properly.

What you gain:

Circular Design projects are highlighted at the Award Show as examples of future-oriented and responsible design. You not only gain visibility, but you also reach the international design community that is actively looking for such solutions.

Service Design

The best service is often invisible – but always felt. Service Design takes design a step further: not as a product or space, but as a holistic experience.

You design processes, interfaces, and interactions so that they are meaningful, understandable, and accessible to people – while also helping organizations act more clearly, efficiently, and humanely. With the new category, Service Design, the German Design Award brings this forward-thinking discipline to the stage. We award projects that convince with intelligent structure, empathetic thinking, and consistent user orientation.

What it's about:

Service Design is interdisciplinary—at the intersection of design, business, technology, and society. It's process-oriented—from idea to execution. It's user-centered—with real value. And it's systemic—because service today is more than a touchpoint: it's a connected experience.

Is your project a fit?

Perhaps you've redesigned a patient experience in healthcare. Or a service process in education that allows real participation. Perhaps you've developed a digital platform that convinces people with clarity and relevance – or an internal company process that reorders complex structures.

If your project shows how services become better, fairer, or more sustainable through good design, then it belongs here – on the stage of the German Design Awards.

How to Convince the Jury

In the registration process, you choose how you want to present your project to the jury. In many categories, you can choose to submit an original product or a digital submission. In some categories, digital submission is mandatory.

Important for your Chances of Success:

The jury needs to assess many projects in a short amount of time. The clearer you convey your idea and its uniqueness, the better it will be noticed – especially for digital submissions.

For example, if you've implemented a particularly sustainable design process, think about how to make that visible at first glance – even without a personal explanation or physical product.

For your guidance, we've put together best-practice examples that show what a convincing submission looks like. This way, you can prepare your materials optimally and increase your chances of winning.

PDF Presentations and Video Clips

To present your project or product optimally to the jury, you can submit a PDF presentation and/or a short video clip.

Since our jury is internationally composed, all content must be in English to ensure your project is understood and assessed correctly.

- mp4 file, max. 180 seconds
- Upload for max. 2 files
- total max. 50 MB
